## **TrackSmart AI Race Report**

#### **Section 1: Race Information**

#### **Section 2: Pace & Trip Projection**

• **Projected Early Leader:** #8 Angel In Paradise

- **Primary Scenario (65% Likelihood):** Contested Pace. With multiple horses possessing gate speed, including #8 Angel In Paradise and #5 Hold My Halo, a duel for the early lead is the most probable scenario. This could lead to fast early fractions.
- Secondary Scenario (35% Likelihood): Uncontested Lead. It is possible that #8 Angel In Paradise is so much quicker than the others that she clears to the front easily, allowing her to control the pace without significant pressure.
- AI Call: Expect #8 Angel In Paradise to blast from the outside post and make a
  determined bid for the lead. #5 Hold My Halo, with an elite driver, will likely leave as well,
  ensuring an honest pace. This setup could prove advantageous for a horse sitting just
  off the speed duel.

# **Section 3: Horse-by-Horse Analysis**

#### #1 - SPORTY LIZ (20/1)

• **TPN Score:** 45

- **Key Strengths:** Elite driver (+10), inside post position (+5), strong betting support in previous races (+5), and triggers a major overlay alert (+7).
- **Key Weaknesses:** Steps up in class, and her speed ratings are lower than the top contenders (-3).
- Analysis: The model flags this horse as the prime value play. Despite a significant class hike, she gets an elite driver and the best post on the track. She was consistently a heavy favorite against weaker company, and her 20/1 morning line triggers a strong overlay signal. If she can handle the tougher competition, her trip from the rail gives her a massive shot at a price.

## #2 - OBSESSED WITH LOU (6/1)

• TPN Score: -6

- **Key Strengths:** Favorable post position (+5).
- **Key Weaknesses:** Declining form cycle (-3), appears fatigued from a long season (-4), consistently dismissed by the public (-3), and has low-percentage driver/trainer connections.
- Analysis: This horse appears to be heading in the wrong direction. The model penalizes her for a declining form cycle and fatigue after 27 starts this year. She benefits from a good post but otherwise looks overmatched.

## #3 - ATI GIRLS LUVCRUZN (9/1)

- TPN Score: 12
- **Key Strengths:** Solid relative speed rating (+9), proven ability to finish in the money at this class level (+5), and strong earnings per start (+3).
- **Key Weaknesses:** Shows a declining form pattern in her last few starts (-3) and is flagged for potential fatigue (-4).
- **Analysis:** A consistent, hard-trying mare who is rarely far from the action. She fits well at this class level and has the speed to be a factor. However, signs of a long campaign may be showing, and she could be vulnerable to fresher rivals.

## #4 - CRYTEL SHADOW (3/1)

- TPN Score: -5
- **Key Strengths:** Possesses a respectable speed rating (+2).
- **Key Weaknesses:** Suffers from a fatigue penalty after 34 starts (-4), is consistently a longshot (-3), and has low-percentage connections.
- Analysis: An off-the-pace closer who would need the front-end to collapse to have his best shot. While he has a decent final kick, his low-percentage connections and the fatigue factor make him a risky proposition at low odds.

#### #5 - HOLD MY HALO (3/1)

- **TPN Score:** 29
- **Key Strengths:** Takes a massive drop in class from the Ohio Sires Stakes (+18) and picks up an elite driver in Dan Noble (+10). Benefits from a good post (+5).
- **Key Weaknesses:** Flagged for potential fatigue from a 25-start season (-4).
- Analysis: The class relief is the most significant factor for this filly. She has been facing much tougher competition and now finds a spot where she should be a dominant force. With a top driver in the bike, she is a logical and formidable contender.

#### #6 - CAPTAINESS (15/1)

- **TPN Score:** -13
- **Key Strengths:** Hails from a high-percentage trainer barn (+5).
- **Key Weaknesses:** Saddled with a very poor post position (-5), has slow speed ratings (-5), shows declining form (-3), and is cold on the betting board (-3).
- **Analysis:** The model strongly dislikes this horse's chances due to a combination of poor recent form and a tough starting spot. While the trainer is excellent, it may not be enough to overcome the numerous negatives. Designated as a Chaos Candidate.

## #7 - GERRY CAMO (20/1)

- TPN Score: 5
- **Key Strengths:** Owns one of the highest relative speed ratings in the field (+9) and

- ranks third in earnings per start (+1).
- **Key Weaknesses:** Hampered by a poor outside post position (-5) and a fatigue penalty from a long season (-4).
- Analysis: This horse has the raw speed to compete with the best in this group but faces significant obstacles. The outside post will force a difficult trip, and she may be feeling the effects of her campaign. A potential longshot to include underneath in exotics. Designated as a Chaos Candidate.

## #8 - ANGEL IN PARADISE (8/5)

- TPN Score: 7
- **Key Strengths:** Top-ranked in earnings per start (+5), always heavily supported by the public (+5), and has a strong driver (+5).
- **Key Weaknesses:** Severely penalized for the outside post 8 (-10) and shows a declining form cycle (-3).
- **Analysis:** The likely favorite and the fastest horse early, but the post position is a major hurdle. She will have to use significant energy to make the lead, and her recent form has been dipping slightly. She is vulnerable to a trip-aided rival.

## #9 - PREMIER MARGARITA (20/1)

- TPN Score: -9
- **Key Strengths:** Has a strong driver (+5).
- **Key Weaknesses:** Penalized for rising in class (-3), declining form (-3), potential fatigue (-4), and being dismissed by the public (-3).
- Analysis: This filly appears to be in tough. She is stepping up to face a more difficult
  group while her own form seems to be waning. The model sees very little to
  recommend. Designated as a Chaos Candidate.

# **Section 4: Final Rankings & Betting Strategy**

## **Contender Rundown (Narrative)**

• Top Pick (#1 SPORTY LIZ): The model identifies a significant value opportunity here.

Despite jumping in class, the combination of the rail post, an elite driver, and a powerful overlay signal makes her the top pick. Her speed figures are a concern, but the perfect trip she is projected to get could make all the difference at huge odds.

- Main Danger (#5 HOLD MY HALO): The most logical winner on paper. The precipitous drop from stakes company to this conditioned event is the strongest handicapping angle in the race. With Dan Noble driving, she will be forwardly placed and very difficult to hold off.
- Overlay & Value Plays: The top pick, #1 SPORTY LIZ (20/1), is the Prime Overlay. For exotic wagers, #7 GERRY CAMO (20/1) is a Chaos Candidate with enough speed to hit the board at a price if the race flow is in his favor.

## **Suggested Bets**

- Primary Strategy: Win, Place, and Show bet on #1 SPORTY LIZ.
- Secondary/Saver Strategy: Exacta box: 1, 5. Trifecta: 1, 5 with 1, 3, 5, 8 with 1, 3, 5, 7, 8.
