### #3 LUCKYCHUCKYFRMO'KY (ML 9-2)

1. **TPN Summary:** Raw 96 -> Final 100 (Tier: Top Contender)
2. **Driver/Trainer:** Sam Widger (Aggression: High) / James Schulte Jr. (0%)
3. **Speed Trend:** RSRs: [92, 78, 81] | Best: 92
4. **Class Analysis:** Last: NW1501L4 -> Today: NW1 (PM) ( **Class Drop**)
5. **Trip/Angles:** Drops from a significantly tougher class where he paced a 1:52.2 mile (finishing 3rd). That speed figure dominates this field of maidens/NW1s.
6. **Gate Speed:** Stalker | Projected Position: Midpack/First-Over
7. **Key Stat:** Paced a 1:52.2 mile on Nov 14; field average is ~1:56.
8. **Betting Sentiment:** Value Play likely if ignored on the board.
9. **Analysis:** The clear class of the field. He drops from conditioned claimers to face NW1 opposition. Despite the trainer's low percentage, the raw speed demonstrated two starts back (1:52.2) is lengths superior to his rivals. If he replicates that effort, he wins.

### #5 SWEETENS COVE (ML 2-1)

6. **Gate Speed:** Leaver | Projected Position: Leader
7. **Key Stat:** Consistent mid-1:55 speed; Tyler Smith drives.
8. **Betting Sentiment:** Likely Favorite.
9. **Analysis:** The likely pacesetter. She consistently leaves the gate (27.2 and 27.3 openers recently) and should control the fractions on this 5/8ths oval. Her recent form at Northfield and Dayton is solid, but she lacks the explosive turn of foot shown by #3.

## #6 LEGENDARY RIDE (ML 3-1)

2. **Driver/Trainer:** Cameron McCown (Aggression: Med) / Jim Arledge Jr (6%)
3. **Speed Trend:** RSRs: [85, 79, 81] | Best: 85
4. **Class Analysis:** Last: NW1PM -> Today: NW1 (**Same**)
5. **Trip/Angles:**  **Driver Intent**
6. **Gate Speed:** Leaver/Stalker | Projected Position: Pocket/3rd
7. **Key Stat:** Paced 1:54.2 in last start (3rd place finish).
8. **Betting Sentiment:** Moderate.
9. **Analysis:** Comes off a very sharp effort on Nov 25 over a "good" track, pacing in 1:54.2. That effort puts him right in the mix with #5. Cameron McCown will likely leave to get position; if he finds the pocket behind #5, he's a major threat.
