Module-by-Module Analysis

Tier 1 Contenders (TPN 97.0 - 100.0)


#14 Half Yours (TPN 100.0):

- **Speed (45%):** Possesses the top Neural Rating (201.0) by a significant margin. His last start TBM_Delta (-3.0) suggests his G1 Caulfield Cup win was flattering, but his overall speed profile is elite.
- **Class (30%):** A G1 winner last start, taking the Caulfield Cup. He is peaking at the absolute highest level.
- **Form (25%):** In dominant form, winning 3 of his last 4 starts, including a G1 and G3. He is clearly the horse in the best form.
- **Conditions:** Thrives on soft ground (3-1-5). The Soft 7 is a major advantage.
- **Verdict:** The horse in peak form, a last-start G1 winner, top Neural Rating, and loves the wet. Despite a slight TBM query, his profile is superior. A clear  **Overlay** (\$11.00 ML vs \$4.20 NR).

#2 Buckaroo (TPN 99.0):

- **Speed (45%):** Ranks 2nd on Neural Rating (175.5). His last start 2nd (0.1L) in the G1 Cox Plate was exceptional, and his TBM_Delta (+0.1) confirms the run was genuine.
- **Class (30%):** A G1-placed (x3) runner, beaten a nose in one of the world's best WFA races. Has the class to win this.
- **Form (25%):** Form is impeccable: 3rd in the G1 Memsie, 2nd in the G1 Underwood, 3rd in the G1 Might And Power, 2nd in the G1 Cox Plate.
- **Conditions:** Handles soft ground well (1-4-7).
- **Verdict:** The classiest horse in the race coming off a career-best run. The step up to 3200m is the only question, but his form is undeniable. A  **Underlay** (\$4.00 ML vs \$5.50 NR).

#4 Vauban (TPN 98.0):

- **Speed (45%):** Ranks 3rd on Neural Rating (157.0). His last start 13th in the Caulfield Cup had a massive TBM_Delta excuse (+3.7), indicating he ran far better than the result.
- **Class (30%):** A G2/G3 winner in Europe, brings elite staying credentials.
- **Form (25%):** Sharp recent trials (1st, 1st) and the TBM excuse last start suggest he is ready. 5th run of the prep.
- **Conditions:** A proven mudlark (Soft 5-4-11, Heavy 0-1-1). The Soft 7 is perfect.
- **Trip/Bias:** Draws the ideal Post 2 to save ground for the entire trip.
- **Verdict:** A world-class stayer who loves the wet, gets a huge TBM excuse, and draws the pole. He is a massive  **Overlay** (\$81.00 ML vs \$7.00 NR) and a primary threat.

#12 Smokin' Romans (TPN 97.0):


- **Speed (45%):** Ranks 4th on Neural Rating (131.0). His TBM_Delta last start was poor (-1.5), suggesting he was flattered by his 8th.
- **Class (30%):** G1 Turnbull winner and G1 placed. Has the high-level class for this.
- **Form (25%):** His form is strong, with a 2nd in a G3 two starts back and 4th in the G2 Herbert Power.
- **Conditions:** Loves soft ground (3-4-16) and is a Flemington specialist (2-3-14).
- **Other:** Elite connections (Melham/Maher).
- **Verdict:** A tough, proven stayer who loves Flemington and the wet. His last TBM was poor, but his overall profile is strong. A massive  **Overlay** (\$401.00 ML vs \$9.50 NR).

Tier 2 Contenders (TPN 93.7 - 96.0)


#6 Presage Nocturne (TPN 96.0):

- **Speed (45%):** Solid Neural Rating (125.0). His 4th in the G1 Caulfield Cup was excellent (TBM_Delta -2.1, slightly flattered).
- **Class (30%):** G1/G2 placed in Europe and G1 placed in AUS. Elite stayer.
- **Form (25%):** Form is superb, 3rd in a G2 and 3rd in a G1 before his 4th in the Caulfield Cup.
- **Conditions:** A true wet tracker (Soft 1-6-8). The Soft 7 is a major plus.
- **Verdict:** A high-class international who is proven on soft ground and ran well in the key lead-up. A solid chance.

#23 Torranzino (TPN 95.9):

- **Speed (45%):** Low Neural Rating (92.0). His last-start G3 Geelong Cup win was flattered by TBM (-2.5).
- **Class (30%):** Stepping up from a G3 win.
- **Form (25%):** In career-best form, winning the G3 Geelong Cup and placing 2nd in the G3 Bart Cummings.
- **Conditions:** Thrives on soft ground (3-4-13) and loves Flemington (0-2-3).
- **Verdict:** The "local" horse in peak form, loves the track and the ground. TBM suggests he might be at his ceiling, but he's a tough stayer. A  **Overlay**.

#16 Onesmoothoperator (TPN 95.8):

- **Speed (45%):** Solid Neural Rating (114.5). His last-start G2 MV Gold Cup win was also flattered by TBM (-3.5).
- **Class (30%):** G2 winner, has the class.
- **Form (25%):** Won his only Australian start, showing he has acclimated.
- **Conditions:** Soft/Heavy record is poor (2-4-18, 0-1-3), but his win was on good. The Soft 7 is a query.
- **Verdict:** A last-start G2 winner who is clearly in form, but the soft ground is a significant concern against his record. A  **Overlay**.

#8 Meydaan (TPN 95.7):

- **Speed (45%):** Good Neural Rating (115.0). His 9th in the Caulfield Cup was TBM-neutral (+0.2).
- **Class (30%):** G3 placed in Europe, 9th in a G1.
- **Form (25%):** Form is solid, with a 2nd and 3rd in G3s before his G1 run.
- **Conditions:** Unknown on soft (0-0-1).
- **Other:** Elite connections (JMac/Crisford).
- **Verdict:** A well-bred international with top connections. The wide barrier (22) and unknown soft-track ability are the major risks.

Recommended Staking: Balanced Approach — Focus on Overlays

Win Betting

- **Primary Win Bet:** #14 Half Yours (ML \$11.00)
- **Value/Press Bet:** #4 Vauban (ML \$81.00) — The model sees a massive pricing error. His profile (TBM excuse, Soft 7, G.Waterhouse) is elite.
- **Saver Bet:** #12 Smokin' Romans (ML \$401.00) — A proven G1 stayer at this track at huge odds.

- **Rationale:** Key the TPN top pick (#14) and the top TBM-excuse horse (#4) over the other class runners.
